



Information on the Christmas Market at Schönbrunn Palace 2010 with prolongation from 29 December 2010 to 2 January 2011

For the first time in 2010 the **two left-side market sections** (looking towards the palace – see plan below) will be open from 29 December 2010 to 2 January 2011.

These two events (Christmas Market until 26 December and New Year's Market from 29 December 2010 to 2 January 2011) are to be regarded as separate events. No one who registers for the Christmas Market is obliged to register for the New Year's Market. Participation in the New Year's Market **alone** is not possible.

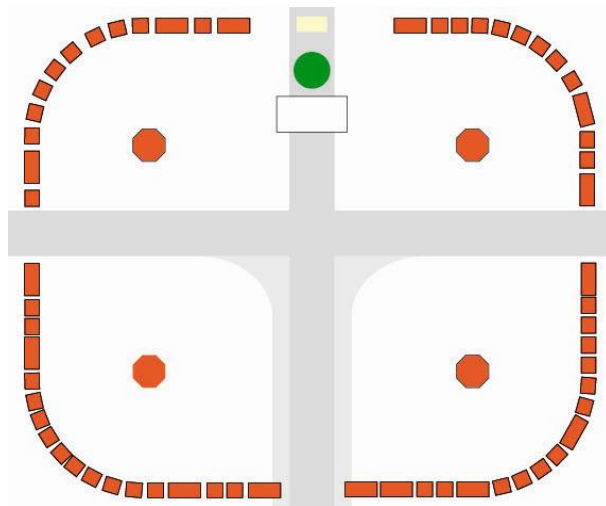
Exhibitors registering for the New Year's Market might have to move. We shall endeavour, however, to ensure that exhibitors wishing to participate until 2 January 2011 already have their stand on the left side. We would like to point out, however, that it is not possible for us to guarantee a specific spot as we also need to ensure that regular exhibitors are given the opportunity to have their usual spot.

We would therefore ask you to indicate your preferences on the registration form.

We would like to emphasise that the prolongation of the market from 29 December to 2 January is NOT in the form of a dedicated New Year's market and the focus will remain on arts and crafts. We therefore ask you to take this into account with your products (should you wish to change them).

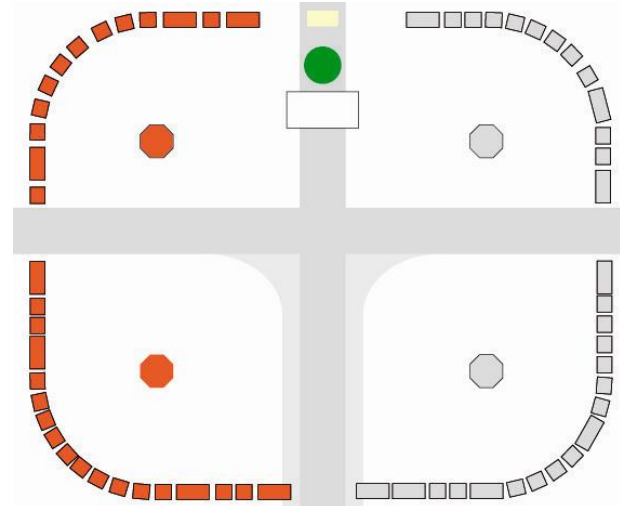
Open / closed market areas
